SATURDAY, JUNE 26, 2010 9AM-NOON**

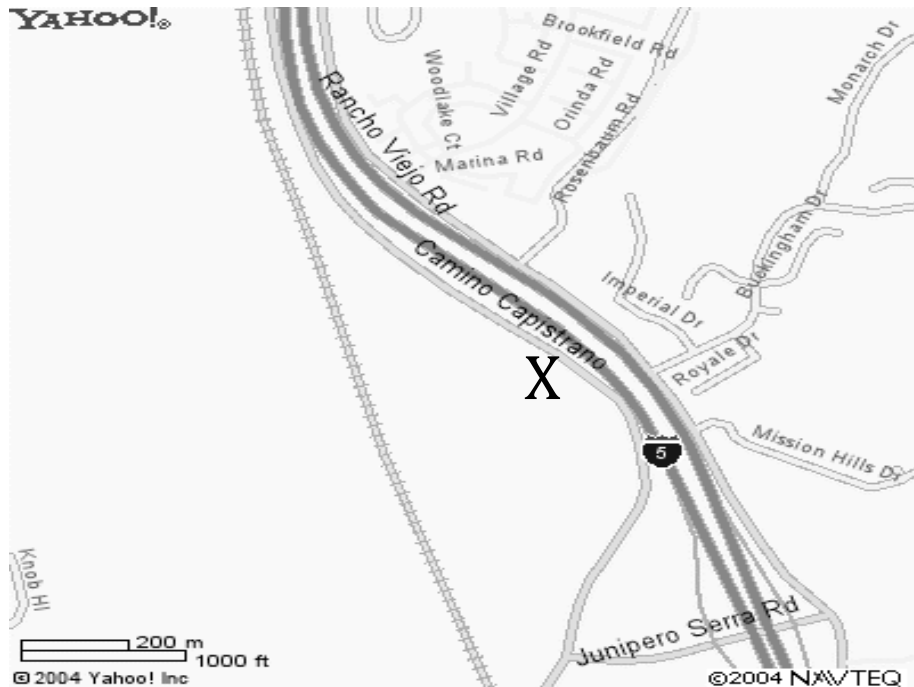
**VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!**
